General Scholarship <i>The Harford County Chamber of Commerce will award a \$1000 General Scholarship.</i>	Engineering Technology Scholarship <i>The Harford County Chamber of Commerce will award one two year tuition/fee scholarship up to \$1900 per year, up to \$3800 for 2 years.</i>
Be a Harford County Resident who will continue post-secondary education at any school	Be a Harford County Resident who will continue post-secondary education at Harford Community College in the Engineering Technology curriculum
Complete a minimum of 6 credits or equivalent per semester	Complete a minimum of 12 credits per semester
