

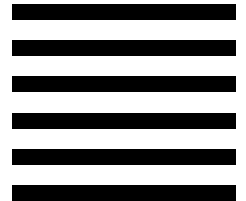
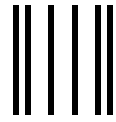
PLEASE READ FIRST:

- Joint members who opened their account **before** September 30, 1987, and who are not a primary member on any account, should call to request a ballot from an Election Representative. 410-272-4000, ext. 3559
- Toll-Free: 800-225-2555, ext. 3559
- You may vote for up to a total of three (3) candidates.
- **Ballots with more than three (3) boxes marked** or without a completed Member Verification form will be declared invalid.
- **Only members age 16 and older may vote.**
- All ballots become the property of the Supervisory Committee.
- Note: Your member number is printed at the top of your statement (also available within online banking, if you are enrolled).

VOTING INSTRUCTIONS:

- **By Ballot:**
 1. Open the flap to expose your ballot.
 2. Read each candidate's biographical information, mark the box next to the candidate(s) you choose, and moisten the gum seal on the bottom, left and right. Fold the bottom panel to the center to seal your ballot. **Seal this panel first.**
 3. Completely fill out the Member Verification form. Moisten the gum seal above the form and on each side, and fold this panel down to close your ballot.
 4. Drop your ballot in the mail. The postage is already paid. You can also drop your sealed ballot in a ballot box at any APGFCU® branch.

Place a check mark in the box next to the candidate(s) of your choice, moisten seal on the bottom, left and right. Fold the bottom panel to the center to seal your ballot. Next, fill out the "Member Verification" form (above) and seal. Ballots must be received no later than **March 24, 2024**. The results of the election will be announced at the Annual Meeting on Thursday, April 18, 2024.
